

Remove Regrowth from Cut Stump and Treat.

Rhododendron Control Method used in Killarney National Park.



This control method was frequently used in Killarney National Park prior to the introduction of stem treating. Rhododendron stumps should be cut as low to the ground as possible (low cut stumps will produce less regrowth and minimises herbicide usage) after a period of 18 months to 2 years remove all regrowth with a hand axe and treat the stump collar with a 10% herbicide solution.



This method is easy to carry out on low cut stumps and requires minimal herbicide useage, it also reduces the risk of collateral damage to surrounding vegetation.
